Dear Mr. Neste:

On behalf of Tyco Fire Products LP, thank you for your letter of July 3, 2019. We will respond in accordance with Wis. Admin. Code Section § NR 716.

In the meantime, could you please provide us with the following information, which will assist us in our response:

1. Has DNR issued any Responsible Party letters to any other persons or entities in this matter?
2. As you know, the City of Marinette tested lines from five wastewater zones that discharge into the City of Marinette Waste Water Treatment Plant and it appears that Tyco Fire Products LP wastewater connects only to three of those five lines. It is our understanding that the other two lines tested positive for PFAS. Has DNR investigated all potential sources of PFAS contamination in any of the lines and, if so, what were its findings?
3. Has DNR investigated whether land applied biosolids from sources other than the City of Marinette were supplied to the properties referenced in your letter and, if so, what were the results of that investigation?
