Re: Temporary Access Permits Over Annie Sun Lane, Center Sugarbush Lane, East
Ross Allen Lake Lane, and Elsie Lake Lane

Dear Chairman Gaulke and Town Board Members,

As you know, the Tribal Council passed Resolution No. 143(23) on May 12, 2023, authorizing the issuance of Temporary Access Permits to the Town of Lac du Flambeau (the "Town") for the Annie Sun Lane, Center Sugarbush Lane, East Ross Allen Lake Lane, and Elsie Lake Lane (the "Four Roads"), contingent upon timely payment of the fees and adherence to other specified conditions.

On August 9, 2024, the Town posted a Town Board meeting agenda online where the Town publicly declared that "the Town is unable, not unwilling, to pay the permit fees for 08/12/24 – 09/12/24. To be clear, the Tribal Council has not amended Resolution No. 143(23) to accommodate the Town's current position. Thus, the Tribe considers the Town to be in default of Resolution No. 143(23).

Please take notice that the Town has until Friday August 23, 2024 to pay all outstanding Temporary Access Permit fees to the Tribe, and failure to pay will result in restricted access over the Four Roads.
